CREEDENCE CLEARWATER REVISITED CONFIRMS FALLSFEST CONCERT DATE
25th Anniversary Event Set for September 25, 2010

(Wichita Falls, TX) –FallsFest , Texoma’s premier outdoor festival is pleased to announce the legendary rock band **Creedence Clearwater Revisited** will be taking the main stage on Saturday night, September 25, in celebration of the 25th anniversary of FallsFest.

Creedence Clearwater Revival's distinctive swamp rock went against the grain of the '60s psychedelic San Francisco and won a worldwide following and numerous gold and multi-platinum singles and albums. It was rebellious, sometimes militant rock, co-opted into three minute radio gems that remain a rock radio and movie soundtrack staple.

After Creedence Clearwater Revival disbanded in 1972, Stu Cook and Doug “Cosmo” Clifford -- who had played together since junior high -- remained close. Realizing both missed playing live Creedence music that had been lying dormant -- with ex-bandmate John Fogerty previously calling for a boycott of and refusing to publicly perform CCR music – Cook and Clifford decided to put together their own band to perform the songs in concert.

Since then, CCR has been playing classics like "Susie Q," "Lodi," "Proud Mary," "Down On The Corner," "Fortunate Son" and "Who'll Stop The Rain" throughout North America, South America, New Zealand, Europe and Asia . Though the pair initially only planned to play private parties, CCR now performs up to 100 shows a year and has released the album "Recollection."

The reaction to CCR's concerts has been astounding, and driven in part by a generation of kids who, as Cosmo says, "weren't even born when the music came out." Likewise, the release of a double-live CD was the result of public demand. "It was generated by requests of the people who came to the shows," Stu acknowledges. "Over and over they would ask, "do you guys have a CD?"CCR's "Recollection" has proven so popular that it was certified as a platinum record by the RIAA in 2008.

As fans who have experienced a CCR concert can attest, Stu and Cosmo found the right players. Lead singer/rhythm guitar player John Tristao is a powerful tenor with the energy to power songs. Lead guitarist Tal Morris has been described as "the quintessential Bay Area guitar prodigy" and his monstrous talent unleashed live is what a rock 'n' roll concert is all about. Talented multi-instrumentalist Steve Gunner rounds out the group. As Cosmo puts it, "Gun provides live all the overdubs that were on the records. He plays keyboard, acoustic guitar, percussion, harmonica and sings the high harmonies."
