Since our foundation in 1957, JLWF has grown to a membership of over 300 women, with active members ranging in age from 21-60. In addition to fundraising for local causes, they give of their time and talents by volunteering a collective 17,000 hours annually.

# INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP

Over 55 years of goodwill, understanding and cultural exchange exists between JLWF and the German Air Force Squadron of the Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training Program at Sheppard Air Force Base. We recognize how important NATO is to our community, and aim to continue to build bridges that strengthen this relationship.



# FOOD FIGHT

Food Fight is a one-day event where JLWF, along with other Junior Leagues from across Texas and Oklahoma, compete to see who can raise the most food for their respective food bank through a Food Bank Challenge. Donation bins are also placed at partnering businesses across Wichita Falls for a week leading up to the big day. Since the inaugural Food Fight in 2017, the Junior League of Wichita Falls has raised over 14 tons of food for the Wichita Falls Area Food Bank.



#### H.E.A.R.T.

#### (Helping Encourage and Reach Teens)

JLWF partners with Barwise Middle School and hosts a one-on-one mentoring program for at-risk 7th and 8th-grade girls. These girls and their mentors discuss various topics such as social media etiquette, self-care, leadership skills, and so much more.





#### PINK PANTRY

Pink Pantry is designed to provide much-needed menstrual supplies to female students in WFISD. Statistically, one in five girls will miss a day of school due to the lack of proper hygiene supplies during their period. By providing discreet bags with hygiene supplies to nurses and counselors for distribution, JLWF hopes to ensure girls with equal opportunity to learn.

#### OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS

Volunteer time and funding assistance are provided in response to immediate, short-term needs in the community through established non-profit agencies. Volunteer time ranges from a few hours to a one-day project. Grants are given in amounts up to \$2,500 each.





## COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE FUND

Funding is provided in response to immediate needs in the community through established non-profit agencies. Grants are distributed each through Fall and Spring cycles.



# PARTNERS IN EDUCATION

JLWF partners with the Wichita Falls Independent School District to enhance student learning through program and project development and implementation. In 2020, JLWF expanded to become a district-wide partner, accepting and reviewing applications from all 25 WFISD campuses.

This volunteer and financial commitment also include a partnership with the Wichita Falls Area Food Bank's PowerPak 4 Kids initiative, an ongoing effort to provide food to at-risk children on weekends and breaks when school meals are not available





# LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Training is a fundamental and integral component of the Junior League mission. Through committee placements and project execution, the Junior League teaches skills and competencies to prepare our members to be effective community leaders.

Leadership development and training is what sets the Junior League apart from other community service organizations, and enables our members to go on to become valuable volunteers for other local nonprofits.

Training also reinforces a second component of the Junior League mission, improving the potential of women.
